

2026 SPRING SHOWCASE

MELODIC REMEDY DANCE STUDIO

SHOW PARTICIPATION:

All dancers are automatically signed up for show participation and expected to perform in ALL shows their class is part of. If your dancer will NOT be performing in the show, please inform us no later than February 15th via this form: ["Showcase Drop Form"](#). It is VERY important we know who is not participating when ordering costumes. **ALL costume fees are non-refundable.** If your dancer is not participating in the show, they are still able to participate with their classes through the end of the season.

SHOW PARTICIPATION FEE:

There is a \$45 Show Participation Fee for each student in the show. This fee helps cover the costs of extra expenses that go into putting on the show, but will also include a showcase t-shirt and access to digital videos of all versions of our shows. No need to record the show yourself – just watch, enjoy and allow us to record every moment for you. The \$45 Show participation fee will be posted to accounts on February 15th.

COSTUMES

Each class will perform in a different costume. (ex. If your child takes 2 classes and is performing with both routines, you will need to purchase two costumes). Costume costs range from \$45-\$90 per class. We will be measuring for show costumes in January and February, so please be sure your child is attending their classes. If your child does not get measured you must send in their measurements (Bust, Waist, Hips & Girth) to us so we can order them the appropriate size costume. Costume payments will be posted to your account on March 1st. All costume payments must be made by March 15th. **ALL COSTUME FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE!!!** Please inform us before February 15th if your dancer is NOT participating in the show so we know not to order and charge you for a costume. If you withdraw from a class or drop from the show after your costume has been ordered, you are still responsible for purchasing the costume.

SHOW DATES:

All shows will be held at the Woodside High School Performing Arts Center. The show your dancer will be performing in is listed further down in this info packet, and can also be found here: [Showcase Breakdown Sheet](#). Dancers are expected to perform in ALL of their assigned shows. Please know that if your dancer does not show up for one of their shows, it affects their entire class! We ask that you & your dancer commit to all of their shows & rehearsals.

MANDATORY DRESS REHEARSAL DATES & TIMES:

Mandatory dress rehearsals are held the week leading up to the showcase and will be at the Woodside High School Performing Arts Center. Your dancer only needs to attend their assigned dress rehearsal. Mark your calendars NOW with your dancers rehearsal & show dates/times to avoid any scheduling issues! Attending these rehearsals are EXTREMELY important as it is the only chance your dancer will get to see the backstage area as well as practice their dance on stage before performing it! Practicing these dances in the studio is VERY different than performing them on stage. We want the dancers to be familiar and comfortable in the theater setting! *Please understand that we have hundreds of dancers and families here at Melodic Remedy. It's an extremely challenging and time-consuming task to schedule these rehearsals & shows. If your dancer takes multiple classes in different age groups or you have more than one child dancing with us, you and your dancers will most likely need to attend multiple rehearsals and shows. We thank you for your commitment and cooperation.*

TICKETS

Tickets will be sold ONLINE ONLY in the few weeks leading up to the show. Any leftover tickets will be sold at the door on the day of the show. You MUST purchase a ticket if you plan on sitting in a seat. **Tickets are assigned seating.** Ticket prices range from \$12 - \$35 depending on the show and location of your seat. Watch for announcements, and **please know that our shows do SELL OUT.** Purchasing tickets when they go on sale is HIGHLY ENCOURAGED. **Tickets are sold through a 3rd party ticketing company, so we are not responsible for any mis-purchased tickets. All refunds/exchanges must be done through the ticketing company.**

TEEN SHOW (6th-12th grade & Adult Dance Classes)

WHAT TO EXPECT ON SHOW DAY

ARRIVAL

Please arrive 30–60 minutes before the show start time. Upon arrival, head directly backstage to get your dancer situated in their designated dressing room. Once your dancer is settled, parents are welcome to make their way to the audience to find their seats.

DROPPING OFF & PICKING UP DANCERS

If you choose to drop off your dancer backstage, they will remain in their dressing room under the supervision of our staff and volunteers for the entire show. Our team will escort dancers onstage for their performance and back to the dressing room afterward.

Little Ones & Kids Show – After the show concludes, parents must come backstage to pick up their dancer. Please do not come backstage mid-show to pick up your dancer; we kindly ask that you wait until the performance has ended.

COSTUME CHANGES

If your dancer is performing in multiple routines and requires assistance with costume changes, parents are welcome to remain in the dressing room to help. If you plan to watch the show from the audience, please ensure your dancer has backstage assistance arranged, as our staff is unable to commit to helping with costume changes.

"Hire a Helper" – If you would like to enjoy the show from the audience, we will have teen dancers available backstage who can be assigned to assist with costume changes. More information will be shared as we get closer to the show date.

BACKSTAGE

If you plan to stay backstage with your dancer, we ask that you remain backstage for the duration of the show to avoid disruptions caused by entering the audience mid-performance. Please note that parents are not permitted in the backstage wing area (the sides of the stage) to watch performances. You may view your dancer's performance on the TV monitors located in the dressing rooms.

SHOWTIME

Each class will perform a 1:30–2:30 minute routine on stage. Every class performs to a different song and wears their own costume. Dancers will remain backstage for the duration of the show. After the show has ended, parents must come backstage to pick up their dancer. Please do not attempt to pick up dancers mid-show.

March 1st - \$45 Participation Fee *charged* with March Tuition Auto-Pay

March 15th - Costume Fees charged to Credit Card/ACH on file ****COSTUME FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE****
